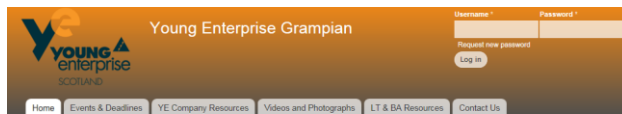

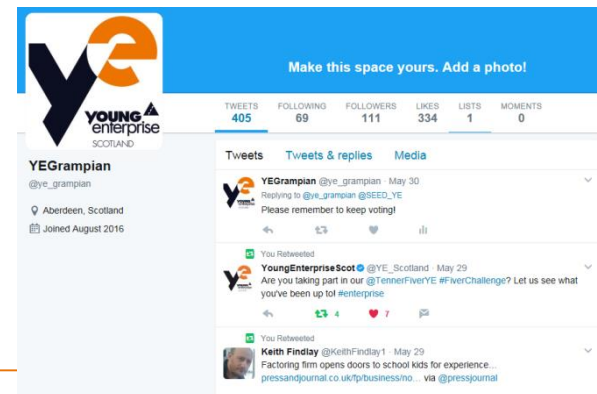
Welcome to YE Grampian

Young Enterprise students say they ...



- ✓ Earn a third more than their peers in the 30+ age group
 - ✓ Are twice as likely to start their own business as their peers
 - ✓ Have greater appreciation of their own skills and the opportunities available to them
 - ✓ Are more passionate about their jobs than their peers - 77% fulfilled and engaged by their jobs, compared to only 59% of their peers
 - ✓ Are more successful in their careers
 - ✓ Are more likely to get involved in voluntary work - 55% compared with 39% for their peers
 - ✓ Amongst business-owners – it is the “the most significant experience” they drew upon
 - ✓ Feel that YE contributed to their skill development more than anything else – and felt best prepared for work
